Fremont-Winema National Forest

A visit to the Crooked Meadow Fen begins at an excavated pond (for fire fighting) at the parking area.



Just 50 yards northeast from the pond are good closeup views of the fen plants from the dry bank.



As this fen narrows and slopes downhill, one can continue east along its dry bank for another 400 yards.

The short hike at Wilshire Meadow Fen starts at a pole fence between the fen wetland and the meadow.



Following the dry banks skirting the branches of this fen gives one close-up views of the unusual fen flora.



The Dry Meadow Fen visit also starts at an excavated fire fighting pond, adjacent to the parking area.



One can wander along the dry banks of this fen for over 500 yards as it drops in elevation to the north.
