

## Trail Map for

### OLD-GROWTH FIRS at CANDLE CREEK

After getting a self-service Wilderness Permit just below the parking area, one follows the Jefferson Lake Trail north as it descends into Candle Creek. After crossing a footbridge, the trail climbs up into the old-growth fir grove.

Within 150 yards, thanks to a remarkable 7'-diameter saw cut, the trail passes through a wind-thrown giant fir. The trail then winds north along Candle Creek through more old-growth trees, with an understory of ferns and maples.

At 0.6 miles, the trail climbs up onto a lava flow, with wide views of the surrounding landscape and Mt. Jefferson to the west. Hike along the lava trail as far as you wish.
